

Directions to Mary Immaculate College, Limerick

If coming from the Dublin direction, follow the M7 to Limerick. At Junction 2, take the N69 exit to Listowel/Limerick (centre). There are two lanes as part of this exit, keep to the right. At the roundabout, take the fifth exit onto Dock Road/N69. At the next roundabout stay on the Dock Road by taking the second exit. At the next smaller roundabout take the second exit, to stay on the Dock Road. After the roundabout, take a right at the second set of traffic lights onto Courtbrack Avenue. Continue straight up this road. At a small roundabout take the first exit (to go straight ahead). You'll be passing the ground of the college on your left. At the next roundabout, turn left, onto South Circular Road. You'll see the college on your left. Drive in the entrance, veering right into the car park. There will be signs to lead you to the TARA building.

If coming from the Cork direction, follow the N20/M20 to Limerick. Take exit 1 for Galway. Continue on this road and take exit 2 for Listowel/Limerick (centre). There are two lanes as part of this exit, keep to the right. At the roundabout, take the fifth exit onto Dock Road/N69. At the next roundabout stay on the Dock Road by taking the second exit. At the next smaller roundabout take the second exit, to stay on the Dock Road. After the roundabout, take a right at the second set of traffic lights onto Courtbrack Avenue. Continue straight up this road. At a small roundabout take the first exit (to go straight ahead). You'll be passing the ground of the college on your left. At the next roundabout, turn left, onto South Circular Road. You'll see the college on your left. Drive in the entrance, veering right into the car park. There will be signs to lead you to the TARA building.

If coming from the Galway direction, follow the N18 for Cork until you reach the toll tunnel. After the tunnel take the first left (exit 2). At the roundabout take the second exit for Limerick Centre. You are now on the Dock Road. At the next smaller roundabout take the second exit, to stay on the Dock Road. After the roundabout, take a right at the second set of traffic lights onto Courtbrack Avenue. Continue straight up this road. At a small roundabout take the first exit (to go straight ahead). You'll be passing the ground of the college on your left. At the next roundabout, turn left, onto South Circular Road. You'll see the college on your left. Drive in the entrance, veering right into the car park. There will be signs to lead you to the TARA building.
